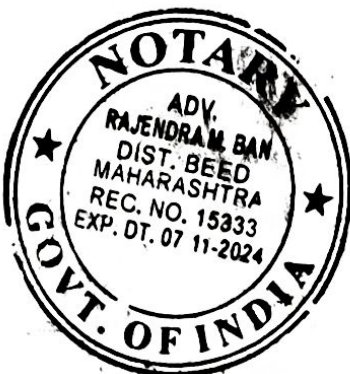

-: Bye-Laws of the Society:-

1. NAME OF THE SOCIETY/INSTITUTION: **Jagdamba Shikshan Prasarak Mandal**

2. ADDRESS OF THE SOCIETY/INSTITUTION: **Beed**

3. DEFINITIONS OF THE TERMS USED IN THE CONSTITUTION:

- a) General Meeting: Meeting conducted by all the members of the society.
- b) Special General Meeting: Meeting called at a short notice for important grounds.
- c) Executive Board: Board made up of incumbent members and associates of the society. They obtain the ultimate verdict in case of a difference of opinion.
- d) Area of Operation: The vicinity of operations of the society shall be in the state of Maharashtra.
- e) Fiscal Year: The fiscal year will be acknowledged from 1 April to 31 March.

4. MEMBERSHIP AND ITS REGISTRATION MODUS OPERANDI:

Any Indian resident above the age of 18 years will be eligible for becoming a member of the institution by fulfilling the following criteria:

- i. The person who desires to become a member of the society shall submit a handwritten application to the secretary stating that he/she shall abide by the bye-laws of the society.
- ii. The application for the membership shall be submitted before the executive board and the decision taken shall be informed to the concerned.
- iii. The executive board shall bear the sole right to accept/reject the application.
- iv. After an affirmative response from the executive board, the applicant shall have to pay a sum of Rs. 5/- as a membership fee.
- v. TYPES OF ASSOCIATE: The society shall have the following types of Associates.
 - a. Lifetime Associate
 - b. General Associate
- a. Lifetime Associate: Any person may apply for becoming a member of this society by fulfilling the eligibility criteria and paying a sum of Rs. 100/- as a subscription.
- b. General Associate: Any person may apply for becoming a member of this society by fulfilling the eligibility criteria in clause 4 of bye-laws and by paying a sum of Rs. 101/- as an annual subscription.

5. CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP:

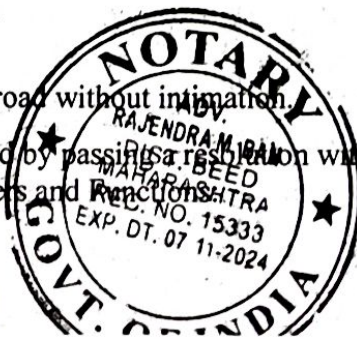
A person ceases to be a member:

- i) On death or
- ii) On his/ her written resignation
- iii) Has not attended 03 consecutive meetings of the general body of the society without intimation
- iv) Has failed to renew the subscription
- v) Have been found of immorality, theft, mischief, gambling or convicted in any criminal cases by the Government.
- vi) Has gone insane
- vii) Has been shifted abroad without intimation.

The membership will be canceled by passing a resolution with a majority in the

6. GENERAL BODY: Its Powers and Functions

The body consisting all the associates shall be considered transcendent and will deliver its final decisions. The Governing Body will be selected from the General Body.
Governing body shall exercise all such powers of the society as are required to be exercised by the society in a general meeting without prejudice to above general power of the governing body shall

have

following powers:

- a. To invest the funds of the society in such a manner as may be.
- b. Shall make future plans and programs and activities to be pursued by the society.
- c. To terminate irregular members as per the regulation of the society.
- d. To appoint new members as per the regulations of the society.
- e. Governing shall meet at least once in a year.
- f. Sanctioning the No Confidence Motion.

7. NOTICE OF GENERAL MEETING:

Notice for the meeting will be issued 15 days prior, including— the topic, venue and timing. Notice will be duly signed by all the members or shall be posted to them all 5 days before. The number of participants for the meeting shall be maximum.

8. SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING:

- a. This meeting shall be called only after a written request from 2/3rd of the members or for discussing important subjects. The quorum of the meeting will be 2/3.
- b. Emergency Meeting: An emergency meeting will be called upon for the most important aspects. A notice for the same shall be issued 24 hours before and the quorum of this meeting will be min. 15 out of 100.

9. GOVERNING BODY AND ITS STRUCTURE:

The Governing Body shall consist min. 7 and max. 11 members. It will include:

10. TENURE OF OFFICE AND ELECTIONS:-

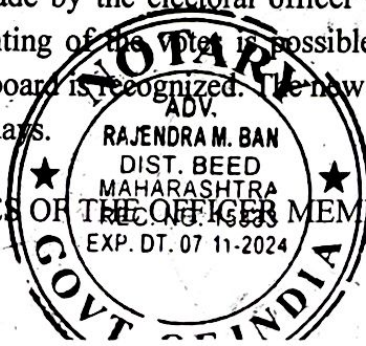
The ordinary term of the governing body will be five years after which election will be held via secret voting method. The electoral officer shall be appointed 5 days prior in the general meeting through a majority decision. The General Body shall declare the date of elections 15 days prior. The candidates shall fill-in their applications 4 days prior. The names of recommender and seconder should be mentioned on the application.

2 to 3 days prior to the elections, the applications will be scrutinized upto 12 in the morning and can be withdrawn upto 5 in the evening. Selection of the members will be done through a secret voting.

- a. Disqualification from election: A candidate shall be disqualified if he is found to be a defaulter under clause 5 (1 and 2) and will be barred under clause 6.
- b. The decision made by the electoral officer will be final and would not be challenged, however, recounting of the votes is possible. The old governing body will function as usual till a new board is recognized. The new Executive Board will be given the charge of work within 15 days.

11. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS MEMBERS.

1. PRESIDENT

President will be head of the society and will preside over the General body and Governing body meeting of the society conveyed by the General secretary for the purpose of carrying out the various activities of the society. The term of the President shall be 05 years and shall be elected by the General body.

2. VICE-PRESIDENT

In the absence of the President, Vice President shall enjoy all power and duties entrusted to the President. He shall take care/supervise functioning of the society as per the orders of the President. The term of the Vice President shall be 05 years and shall be elected by General body.

3. GENERAL SECRETARY

The term of the General Secretary shall be 05 years and shall be elected by General body.

- To sign on behalf of the society all correspondents and to maintain the records of the proceedings of the meeting of general body.
- To summon and attend the meeting of general body.
- To call ordinary or special general meeting if desired in terms of the constitution of the society.
- He shall also represent the society at various quorum functions.
- To bring forward new ideas and ventures and head them in making them a successful one.
- He shall maintain the day to day reports of functioning of the society.

4. JOINT-SECRETARY

Joint Secretary be subordinate to general secretary and help him to discharge duties of Gen. Secretary. The Gen Secy may bestow duties as to them from time to time; the joint Secretary shall enjoy all the powers and duties entrusted to the General Secretary through the absence of General Secretary.

5. TREASURER

He shall keep and maintain all books of accounts of all receipts and payments of the society and to furnish all necessary information to governing body. The treasurer shall be responsible for getting the accounts of the society audited from the certified chartered accountant annually.

6. OTHER MEMBERS

They shall assist the General Secretary in the official job; attend all the meetings, authorize the declaration and vote.

12. MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY AND MEETING ON DEMAND.

The meeting of the Governing Body shall be conducted at least thrice in a year. If 2/3 of the members or 3 out of 7 members make a written application to the General Secretary, then a Meeting on Demand will be conducted. However, if the Secretary denies holding a meeting, then the President bears an authority to call a meeting on demand.

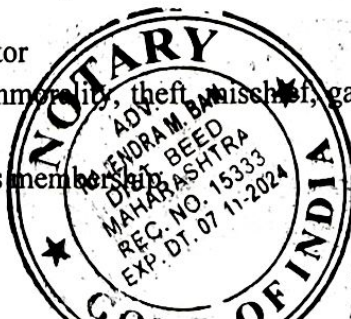
13. NOTICE OF THE MEETING AND QUORUM.

Notice for the meeting will be issued 8 days prior, mentioning— the topic, venue and timing. Notice will be duly signed by all the members or shall be posted to them all 5 days before. The number of participants for the meeting shall be maximum.

14. POLICY REGARDING THE ELECTORAL PROGRESSION OF THE GOVERNING BODY.

Any member who is willing to run for the election should have completed min. 6 months of tenure as a member of General Body. He shouldn't be a defaulter/ debtor. A member shall be disqualified to contest an election if:

- He is a defaulter/ debtor
- Has been found of immoral, theft, mischievous, gambling or convicted in any criminal cases by the Government
- Has resigned from his membership
- Goes insane



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- e. Has gone abroad for more than a year.

15. POLICY REGARDING FILLING VACANT POSTS IN THE GOVERNING BODY.

- a. If any post in the governing body goes vacant due to any reason, the Governing Body shall fill it by choosing member(s) from the General Body. The post filled by the Governing Body will be considered vacant within two months from the date of the last General Meeting.
- b. If any member wishes to resign from his post; he/she will have to submit a duly signed handwritten resignation. The Secretary shall put forth the same before the Governing Body and the decision taken there upon should be informed to the concerned. The post will not be considered vacant till the resignation is not accepted.

16. DUTIES AND RIGHTS OF THE GOVERNING BODY.

- i. To monitor the works done by the President and the General Secretary
- ii. To mandate the branches of the Society
- iii. To appoint new staff
- iv. To sanction their leaves upto 15 days
- v. To conduct meeting atleast once in 4 months or thrice in a year
- vi. Quorum for meetings would be 2/3.

17. SOURCES OF INCOME.

Subscription, membership fee, donations, special contribution, Grant-in-Aids, Gifts and local donation.

Note: Income of the society shall be utilities for the attainment of the aims and objectives of the society.

- a) By way of receiving and collection any gift subscription and donation either in cash or kind or aquire funds and property moveable or immovable by lawful means and to spend and utilize the same for the fulfillment of all or anyone of the aims and objects of the society.
- b) To sell transfer mortgage hypothecate pledge assign gift raise loan form financial institutions and settle or otherwise dispose off or charge the properties of the society either moveable or immovable for the purpose of attaining the aims and objectives of the society.
- c) All the income earning from moveable or immoveable properties of the society shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of aims and objects only set forth in the memorandum of Association- No portion thereof shall be paid or transferred either directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus, profits of, any manner whatsoever be to the present or past member of the society or any person claiming through any or more of the present or past members.
- d) To seek and accept financial assistance from government, NGO's foundation banks business houses and such other organization for undertaking development projects and to fulfill the aims and objects of the society.

18. OBJECTIVE-BASED PROVISION OF EXPENDITURE.

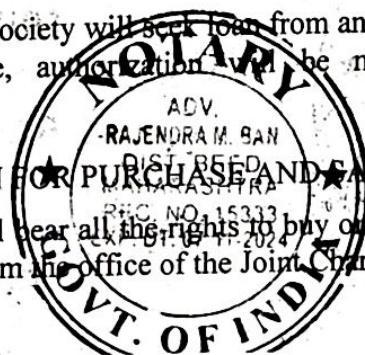
A window of 5% to 50% will be spent on fulfilling the objectives of the society; whereas, as and when required, the expenditure window/ percentage of the amount will be decided in the General Meeting.

19. PROVISION REGARDING LOANS OR DEPOSITS.

If required, the society will seek loan from any bank, financial corporation, and person or will accept deposits. Hence, authorization will be mandatory from the agency of the Joint Charity Commissioner.

20. PROVISION FOR PURCHASE AND SALE OF IMMOVABLE PROPERTY.

The society shall bear all the rights to buy or sale unnecessary property of the society only after the authorization from the office of the Joint Charity Commissioner.

21. BANKING OPERATIONS.

The account of the society shall be opened in any nationalized or scheduled Bank and shall be operated by the President, General Secretary and Treasurer jointly, or any two members of the Governing body authorized by Governing body.

22. METHOD OF LISTING MEMBERS.

A list of members shall be conserved according to the Schedule 1,2 and 6 of The Maharashtra Society Registration, 1971 by attaching necessary documents and duly undersigned by the debtors.

23. PROVISION FOR AMENDMENT IN THE BYE-LAWS.

Amendment in the Constitution or Bye-Laws of the Society will be done through a majority of votes in a General Meeting.

24. PROVISION FOR RENAMING THE SOCIETY OR ALTERING OBJECTIVES.

Renaming of the society or altering/changing/amending the objectives will be formulated according to Clause 12 and 12A of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

25. DISSOLUTION.

The society shall deem to be dissolved under Clause 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

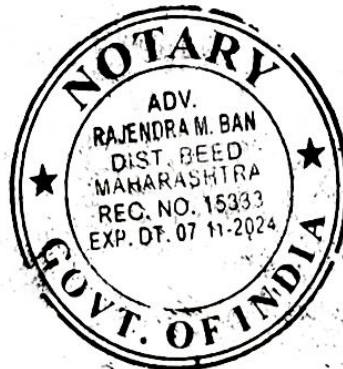

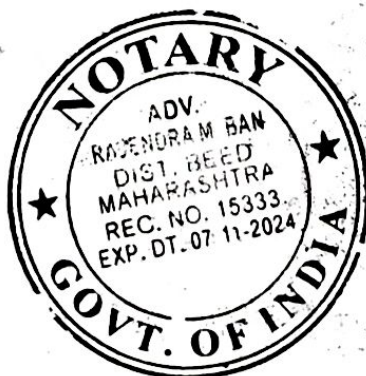

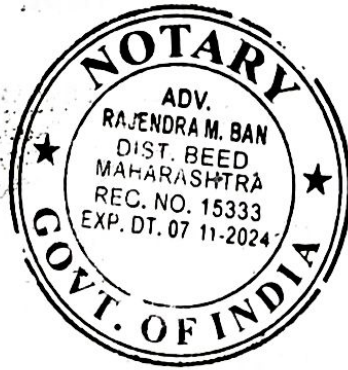
